

Rules for the Quarantine of Your Dog

The dog must be kept at home at all times. The dog may only be taken outside the house on a leash, under the control of an adult. The dog may not be in contact with any persons other than the owners. The dog may not be in contact with any other animals. If the dog becomes ill or starts to act strangely you must immediately notify the Animal Control Officer.

If the dog should get away from the owner, you must immediately notify the Police Department so they may dispatch animal control. If the dog should bite any person or animal during this quarantine you must immediately notify the Health Officer.

If you cannot quarantine this dog you may take it to the animal shelter for the quarantine period at a cost of \$35.00 per day payable in advance. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in fines, and the dog being taken to the animal shelter for the remainder of the quarantine period at the cost stated above.

Understand that failure to comply with these rules is a violation of N.J.S.A.26: 4-82 resulting in the dog being impounded by animal control and possible prosecution.
